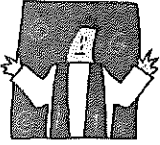

Dear fellow parishioners:

To continue my "series" about what all Catholics should know, I'd like to give you some of the prayer responses that you may or may not know. These are ones that should be committed to memory and become as automatic as: "*The Lord be with you. And*

with your Spirit."

This practice of "call and response" is a way that was used – and still is – for the Jewish people in learning the scriptures. Remember that the scriptures were originally handed down verbally – not written. What would happen is the teacher would speak the first part of a scripture and the student would respond with the back half. There are some places, in businesses, advertising, etc., that this is used as well. Think: *Have it your way – at Burger King.*

If you are interested in getting more familiar with scriptures during Lent (or beyond!), I suggest trying the *Book of Proverbs*. It is attainable to most readers, and holds many truths that are "quick learns" and for the most part uses the "call and response" method. You can't go wrong with anything from that book. One example is: "*Spare the rod – and spoil the child.*" You may not like the corporal punishment aspect; however, it can be adapted to recognize the need of discipline and consequences for actions (positive and negative).

Here are a several phrases that I have noticed over the year that people forgot, or didn't learn, and should be part of every Catholic's repertoire.

For funerals and/or remembrance of deaths:

P: Eternal rest grant unto him/her/them, O Lord.

R: And let perpetual light shine upon them.

P: May his/her/their soul/s and the souls of all the faithful departed rest in peace.

R: Amen.

Greetings or blessings:

1. *P: Let us bless the Lord.*

R: And give Him thanks.

2. *P: Our help is in the name of the Lord.*

R: Who made heaven and earth.

P: Blessed be the name of the Lord.

R: Both now and forever.

There are many others that we already know – I invite/challenge you to memorize these – teach them to and practice them with your children or friends. They can be added to your *Grace Before (or After) Meals*, which I am sure you are all already doing... If not doing this last thing – then I challenge you do it as well. In case you don't remember:

Before: *Bless us, O Lord, and these Thy gifts which we are about to receive from Thy bounty through Christ, our Lord. Amen.*

After: *We give you thanks, almighty God, for these and all Thy benefits which we have received through Christ, our Lord. Amen. May the souls of all the faithful departed through the mercy of God rest in peace. Amen.* Let us pray for each other. Know that you are in mine always.
